We only need to listen to a news broadcast to know we are part of a culture of finger-pointing, defamation, and retaliation. The sullied overflow of this culture affects our view of forgiveness. We are in a spiritual battle. Forgiveness is hard. To forgive does not mean that we deny that someone has hurt us or that we need to allow their influence in our lives. When we forgive, we are the prisoner who is set free. Forgiveness is a divine imperative; forgive to be forgiven.

And always, we begin again, as the Benedictines say. God will enable us, by grace, to go from where we are to where we need to be. If only we ask. Let us look to Jesus and the cleansing spring that flows from his side, for, after all, he has cancelled the debt against us.
