God of everlasting mercy, who in the very recurrence of the paschal feast kindle the faith of the people you have made your own, increase, we pray, the grace you have bestowed, that all may grasp and rightly understand in what font they have been washed, by whose Spirit they have been reborn, by whose Blood they have been redeemed. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever, Amen.

Divine Mercy Sunday, 7 April 2024: Prayers and Devotions begin at 3:00pm, including Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, Veneration of the Image, and concluding with Benediction.

There will be Reconciliation beforehand from 2:30pm. All welcome!

To observe Divine Mercy Sunday fittingly, we:

- 1. Celebrate the Feast on the first Sunday after Easter by praying along in Mass,
- 2. Sincerely repent of our sins,
- 3. Place our complete trust in Jesus,
- 4. Go to Confession on that Sunday or within seven days before or after the Feast,
- 5. Receive Holy Communion on the day of the Feast,
- 6. Venerate the Image of The Divine Mercy,
- 7. Be merciful to others, through our actions, words, and prayers on their behalf.

Jesus said to Saint Faustina: "I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially poor sinners. On that day, the very depths of my mercy are open. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is my desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy." (Diary 699)
