A reminder that as from next weekend, the time for the Saturday evening Vigil Mass moves to 5:30pm due to Daylight Saving (not 6:00pm as in previous years). It is currently proposed to keep the Vigil Mass at 5:30pm all year round from now on, to avoid confusion. Sorry for any inconvenience caused.

**Kairos – Mannus Prison** The mission of Kairos is to share the transforming love and forgiveness of Jesus Christ to impact the hearts and lives of incarcerated men, women, and youth as well as their families, to become loving and productive citizens of their communities.

The Kairos team will present a short course at Mannus Prison, near Tumberumba for four days from 15-18 October. The aim is to reassure these people of God's great mercy and compassion, to be able to go forward with confidence knowing that the community care and want the best for each person.

So, as a Parish how can we help? The Kairos team have reached out and asked us to participate in making home-made biscuits. Each day of the course biscuits are served and each participant who will take a bag of biscuits with them back to their Unit. However, there are two rules – no fruit in the biscuits and no sprinkling of icing sugar on top. Please use ice-cream containers or something similar for the biscuits. Biscuits can be dropped off at the Marian Centre on Saturday or Sunday 12-13th October after the Masses.
